Sunday 21st July 2019



The 3rd Swansea Fish Photo Shoot, organised by the Combined Hunter Underwater Group (CHUG), was run on 21st July 2019.

Teams sent in photos of up to 15 different fish species, and scored 1 pt for each clear photo, 1 pt for each correctly identified species, and 1 pt for each species no other team submitted (max. 45 pts)

Scoring was very tight with a top score of 38 pts by Meryl & Chris.

The most unusual fish was a *Gymnothorax eurostus* (White-speckled moray) found by Matt Dowse and Graham McMartin. This tropical species was well south of its usual range!





